Introduction:

This MMSF, Inc., is a nonprofit organization, incorporated in May 2002, and is comprised entirely of volunteers, that raises funds through donations, Events, raffles and organized rides, to assist local families of motorcyclists injured or killed in motorcycle accidents in financial need as a result of that accident, and to promote motorcycle awareness to reduce these accidents. We have been active and involved the past 21 years, after three years doing "Nelson's Ride" and his family said, "Thank you, please stop giving us money but please continue helping other area families of riders in need. We can match families in current need with past families we have assisted. We depend upon the our local motorcycle community who entrust their donations to us.

We do not make cash donations to families. We assist families in need generally by paying some household bills directly to the providers, for 1-3 months of IMMEDIATE need, to help the family through the toughest of times. Generally, the injured or deceased motorcyclists contributed forty percent (40%) or more income to the household.

We will generally organize a "Friends of _____" Memorial Event or Ride, or host a 'Go Fund Me' page, which requires the family's support and participation. The family generally assists us with promoting the Event.

The MMSF, Inc., will generally advance up-front Event expenses and be reimbursed from the Event's proceeds, to replenish the available funds for the next victims' families. Proceeds of such fundraising Events have been donated to assist the family or back to the MMSF. We DO NOT PAY medical bills but can help with some co-payments to assist the family.

The MMSF, Inc., also uses funds to promote motorcycle awareness and education, attempting to educate and reduce motorcycle accidents and injuries.
